Lidded Gourd Container Workshop

Internationally-known, award-winning gourd artist Carolyn Rushton from Glenwood, Indiana will teach a gourd container workshop from 10 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Saturday, September 22 in the Community Room of the Jay County Public Library, 315 North Ship Street in Portland.

Class participants will learn to paint and decorate a lidded gourd container with beads, feathers and wood burning. They will also learn to clean and finish the interior of the gourd. The containers will be in various sizes and shapes, depending on the gourd used. Carolyn is the only gourd artist to win Best in Show in three states in the same year. Her work is published in eight gourd books. Carolyn's gourds are on every continent in the world except Antarctica. She has been active for many years in the Indiana Gourd Society.

The class fee of \$40 includes instruction and all materials. Minimum age of participants is 12. Lunch is on your own or you may bring a sack lunch. Participants must be pre-registered.
