National Center for Great Lakes Native American Culture Inc. (NCGLNAC) will present a one-day workshop, Saturday, August 25, 2007, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Jay County Historical Society, 903 East Main Street in Portland, Indiana.

This class will cover some of the wild plants in Indiana and their edible, technical and some of their medicinal uses. We will be able to work with the plants, although which ones will be determined by the weather and what plants are ready to be harvested. The class will be able to taste the wild edibles that are prepared in class, as well as make cordage from various plants. The class will learn about plants that are culturally important to the Miami Native Americans, who are the indigenous people of the area. Through this class, we are learning and passing on the old ways to the next generation, which is important for cultural continuity and understanding our own history. Dani is a member of the NCGLNAC Advisory Board, the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma Cultural Committee and volunteers with the Mihsihkinaahkwa Pow Wow in Columbia City. Dani and Bob Tippmann have been married 27 years and have 10 children and 7 grandchildren and live south of Columbia City, Indiana.

The class fee of \$30 includes instruction and all materials. Minimum age of participants is 12. Lunch is on your own or you may bring a sack lunch. Participants must be pre-registered.
