On November 12, in the East Meeting Room of the Tippecanoe Arts Federation, 638 North Street, Lafayette, Indiana, Boni Bent Nelson (Cherokee descent) will teach a class on porcupine quillwork for ages 12 and up. Class participants will learn several different stitches for sewing porcupine quills to leather and complete a small project to take home. Basic porcupine quill embroidery and beading techniques will be covered. A variety of quills and beads will be available. The registration fee of \$35 covers the instruction and all materials. Class registration deadline is November 4.
