Katrina Mitten, of Huntington, Indiana, will teach a class on beading a Whimsey Bird to ages 12 and up on November 10 at the Tippecanoe Arts Federation, 638 North Street in Lafayette, Indiana. The class begins at 10 and ends at 4 with a one hour break for lunch. Katrina is a member of the Miami Tribe of Oklahoma and is a direct descendant of Chief Little Turtle’s sister Tacumwah and also of Chiefs Richardville and Lafontaine. Katrina has also been involved with numerous films about Native Americans. She is nationally-known for her beautiful traditional beaded objects, which she has displayed at many venues, including the Eiteljorg Museum of American Indians and Western Art, Santa Fe Indian Market and Angel Mounds. She has been honored with an Eiteljorg Indian Market Purchase Award.

In this class Katrina will teach participants her own beading techniques as they make and complete at least one Whimsey Bird from wool and size 11 beads. This will include learning edge beading and embroidery. Class is limited to age 12 and up. The class fee of \$35 includes instruction and all materials. Lunch is on your own or you may bring a sack lunch. Participants should be pre-registered before November 3.
