Dear NCGLNAC Members and Friends,

As a valued friend of National Center for Great Lakes Native American Culture, Inc., we are asking you to donate to our two-year Campaign. Our fund-raising goal for the 2012-2013 campaign is \$10,000. The campaign will help NCGLNAC with our yearly operating expenses: ongoing adult and youth programs, art and culture classes, scholarships for classes, our participation at numerous educational events, the lecture series, the Gathering of Great Lakes Nations, printing and postage expenses, hiking trail upgrades and infrastructure, and educational outreach.

NCGLNAC had a very busy year in 2012. 2013 will be even busier. Our 12th annual spring cultural arts classes will be held March 23 and 24 where four adult classes and one children's class will be offered. The 8th annual Academic Conference "*Current Research in Great Lakes Native American Culture*" will be April 20, one-day cultural arts classes will be held May 18 (Wild Plant Identification), October 26 (Beaded Animals) and November 9 (Beaded Whimsy Birds), the 10th Annual Gathering of Great Lakes Nations will be June 8 and 9, the 13th annual summer cultural arts classes for adults and children will be August 3, 4 and 5, with 12 classes offered for adults and children. Donations have made it possible for NCGLNAC to offer several scholarships for these classes. The Fall Friendship Fire weekend will be October 26 and 27 and the annual bead, art and jewelry sale will be November 9. Educational lectures will be March 23 and October 26. Other events NCGLNAC will be participating in include school visits and programs, Scout Leader Training, Kalamazoo Living History Fair, Eiteljorg Indian Market, Jay Heritage Festival, and several area and statewide events. We will continue the upgrades and maintenance of our hiking trail. And we continue to serve as a resource to those seeking Great Lakes Native American instructors and lecturers.
