### **Poster Contest Winners to be Announced**

**Portland, IN – June 8, 2009.** Winners of the 2009 NCGLNAC Gathering of Great Lakes Nations poster contest will be announced Saturday June 13 at 11:30 a.m. at the Tri-State Antique Gas Engine and Tractor Grounds, 1010 Morton Street, Portland, during the 6<sup>th</sup> Annual NCGLNAC Gathering of Great Lakes Nations Pow Wow.

The poster contest *Eastern Woodlands Indian Culture* is sponsored by National Center for Great Lakes Native American Culture (NCGLNAC) and is open to all students in the Jay School Corporation and the Jay Christian Academy. Each age division will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place prizes. First prize is one free children's art class at the NCGLNAC summer cultural arts classes August 3 – 7. Second prize is a NCGLNAC tee shirt and third prize is a bronze medallion.

Posters were judged for their accuracy in the description of Eastern Woodlands Indian people of Jay County and the surrounding area and their culture, both today and in the past. Children were encouraged to research into factual depictions of the Eastern Woodlands peoples and to not portray the inaccurate "Hollywood" stereotypical Indian people. Many excellent posters were turned in by the May 27 deadline.

The poster contest will be an annual event in conjunction with the Annual NCGLNAC Gathering of Great Lakes Nations Pow Wow.
